

PRODUCTIVITY TIP FOR JANUARY

For example, if you are installing a bank of toilets, go through & install all the bowls first. Then come back & put in the seats. Then go through & do all the flush valves. (repetition will always increase productivity; the more simple the task, & the longer you can stay on that task the faster it will get)

Players serve up fun at indoor pickleball courts











2022 Employee Referral Program



Program Rules:

- ✓ Annual Drawing: At the end of the year, we will hold a drawing. The employee that wins will receive a free vacation*
- ✓ To be eligible for (1) raffle ticket, an employee must notify HR in writing of the employee referral and the candidate must verify the referral is true. There are no maximum referrals per employee.
- ✓ The referring employee must agree to have his or her name used when JRT is contacting the candidate.
- ✓ The first employee to refer a candidate will be the only referring employee eligible for reward.
- ✓ Only candidates who meet the qualifications for the position will be considered.

- ✓ The referral (new hire) must be hired and in good standing with JRT at the time of the drawing to earn reward. The candidate cannot have applied to JRT in the past year and must be hired on as a full-time permanent employee.
- ✓ Any disputes or interpretations of this program will be handled through HR.
