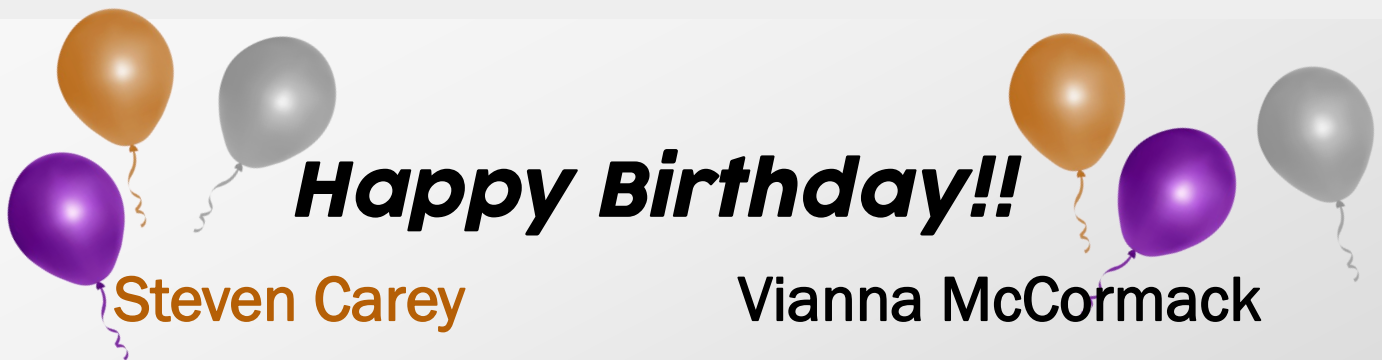

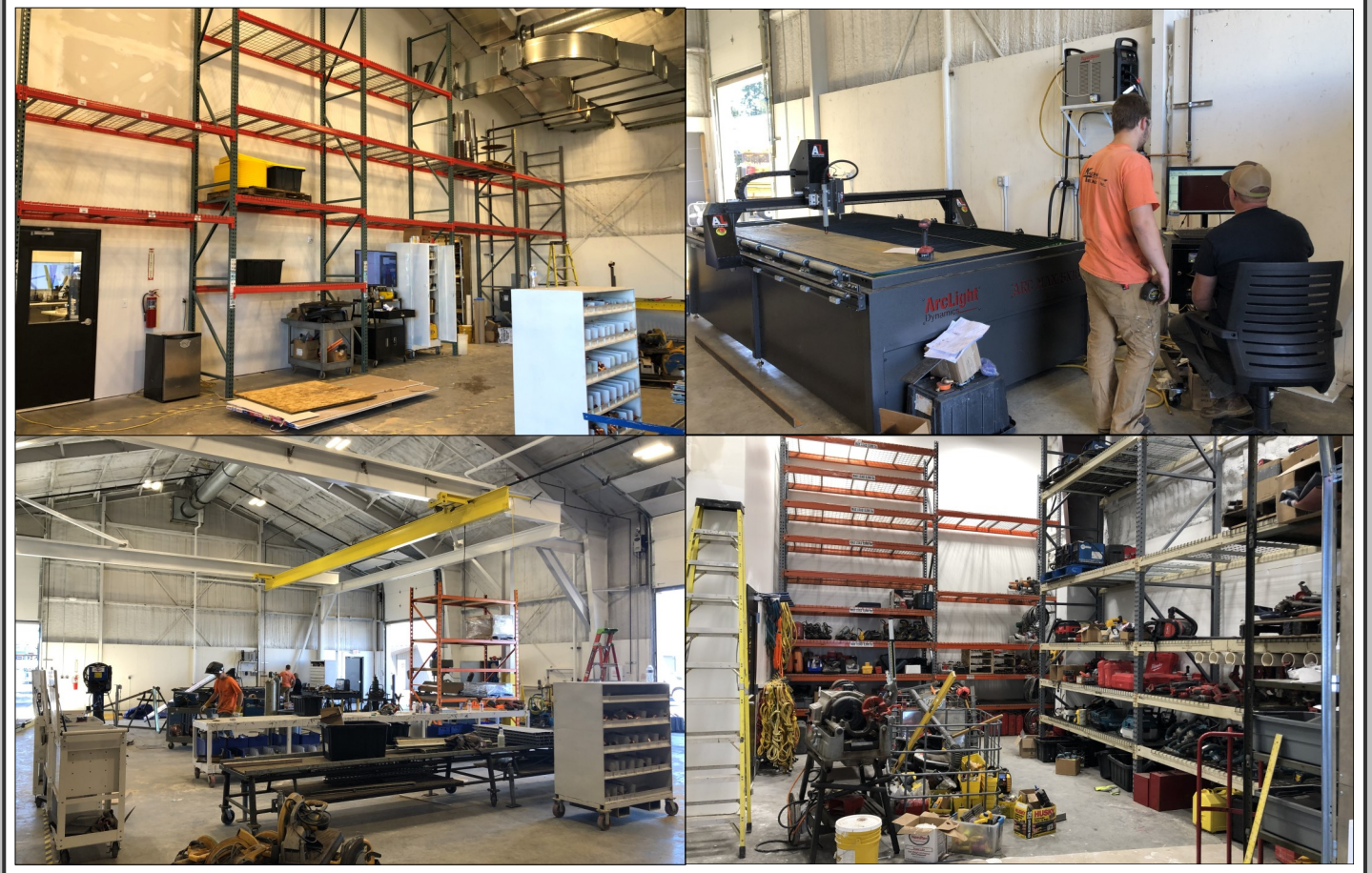
Grayson Bailey
